The Ministry of Labour, Jobs and Employment, together with the National Tripartite Committee, held the 2026 Annual National Labour Conference in Ho under the theme, “Strengthening Industrial Harmony as a Catalyst for Accelerated Economic Growth and National Development.” The three-day conference brought together government officials, employers, organised labour, and stakeholders to discuss employment, decent work, pensions, and the future of work. Vice President H.E. Prof. Jane Naana Opoku-Agyemang called for stronger collaboration and innovation in the changing world of work, while the Volta Regional Minister, Hon. James Gunu, emphasized dialogue, partnership, and national unity as key drivers of sustainable development.
